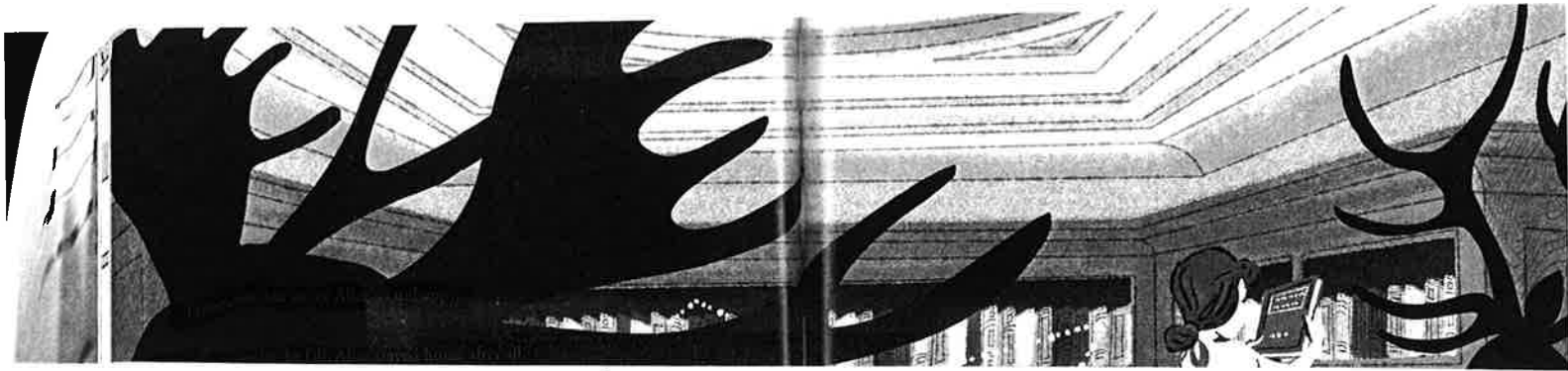




4. To the nearest inch, measure the perimeter shown around Teddy Roosevelt's handprint (It's not really his handprint) (That would be creepy).
